Privacy Policy

Introduction

We at The Lord's Children are committed to respecting your online privacy and recognize your need for appropriate protection and management of any personally identifiable information (Personal Information) you share with us.

The Lord's Children has established this Online Privacy Policy so that you can understand the care with which we intend to treat your Personal Information.

Personal Information means any information that may be used to identify an individual, including, but not limited to, a first and last name, a home, church or other physical address and an email address or other contact information, whether at work or at home. In general, you can visit our Web pages without telling us who you are or revealing any Personal Information about yourself.

If you choose to provide us with your Personal Information on the Web, we may transfer that Information within **The Lord's Children** or to our third-party service providers, across borders, and from your country or jurisdiction to other countries or jurisdictions around the world.

The Lord's Children strive to comply with all applicable laws around the globe that are designed to protect your privacy. Although legal requirements may vary from country to country, we intend to adhere to the principles set forth in this Online Privacy Policy even if, in connection with the above, we transfer your Personal Information from your country to countries that may not require an adequate level of protection for your Personal Information. In other words, our goal is to provide protection for your Personal Information no matter where that Personal Information is collected, transferred, or retained.

Cookies and Other Tracking Technologies

Our Webpages do not utilize cookies or other tracking technologies. A cookie is a small text file that may be used, for example, to collect information about Web site activity. Some cookies and other technologies may serve to recall Personal Information previously indicated by a Web user. Most browsers allow you to control cookies, including whether or not to accept them and how to remove them.

Tracking technologies may record information such as Internet domain and host names; Internet protocol (IP) addresses; browser software and operating system types; clickstream patterns; and dates and times that a site is accessed.

Notice

The only place on our website where we collect personal Information is for the purpose to have us contact you via email to notify you of certain information you requested to receive from us like book promotions, discounts, TV, radio, cablecast or other networks that The Lord's Children has a broadcast interest.

Where we do collect information only three pieces of information is required: and eMail address, First Name and Last Name. Any other information requested is optional and need not be provided.

Security

Wherever your Personal Information may be held by The Lord's Children, we intend to take reasonable and appropriate steps to protect the Personal Information you share with us from unauthorized access or disclosure. For example, our subscriber list is maintained in an off-line environment and when we send emails, your name and email address is masked from all others receiving email from us.

Unsubscribe

All emails received by you come with an unsubscribe link in the email and at various locations on our website. However, you must unsubscribe using the same email address you used to subscribe.

Access/Accuracy

To the extent that you do provide us with Personal Information, we desire to maintain accurate Personal Information. You may contact us via email or phone to update any personal information change provided in the "Contact Us" section of our website.

Third Party Services

Third parties provide certain services available on The Lord's Children website and may collect information during the course of business like that of our e-commerce application for books and other related for sale items. Personal Information collected by third-party service providers help us deliver programs, products, information, and services. Service providers are also an important means by which The Lord's Children maintain its website and distribution lists. We take reasonable steps to ensure that these third-party service providers are obligated to protect Personal Information they collect on our behalf.

The Lord's Children does not intend to transfer Personal Information without your consent to third parties who are not bound to act on our behalf unless such transfer is legally required. Similarly, it is against a violation of our privacy policy to sell any Personal Information collected without expressed consent.

Children's Privacy

The Lord's Children is not structured to attract children. Accordingly, we do not intend to collect Personal Information from anyone we know to be a minor though we have no means to determine the ages of those who visit our website. While our content is Christian we do offer books that may be beyond the intellectual and spiritual capacity of children.
